Some Basic Rules for Competitors

Heritage snaffle bit class—Ridden 2 handed in a snaffle regardless of age. No western saddles permitted. Can not compete in junior, senior, amateur, masters.

Open horse— Junior & Senior horses eligible.

Junior Horses—Horses 3-5yo, regardless of rider level. Can be ridden in a snaffle, hackamore or curb bit one handed.

Senior horse—Horses 6yo and over. Ridden one handed in a curb bit with split reins or roma.

Amateur and Masters—Must hold a current permit issued by your breed association.

Youth rider— Open to youth 7 to 18yo. Horses to be ridden in accordance with horses age.

Green—Any age horse ridden 2 handed in a snaffle or hackamore. Any safe saddle permitted.

Intermediate—Any legal snafflebit or legal headgear. Any safe saddle.

Western attire

- ◆ Long sleeved, collared button up shirt
- ◆ Western hat or ASS approved safety helmet
- ◆ Western pants/jeans
- ◆ Western boots
- ◆ Optional attire—necktie, scarf, spurs, chinks and chaps in ridden classes

Back Numbers are per horse/rider combination and must be displayed when competing.

As per AQHA rules no training equipment is to be used one hour before start of show or one hour after the show.

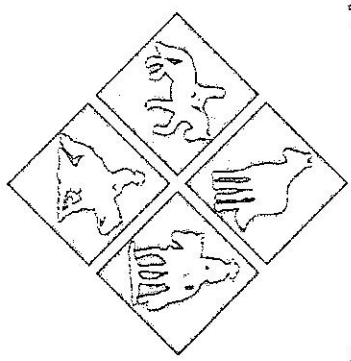

- ◆ All bracks, registered or unregistered welcome
- ◆ No horses under 3yo may be exhibited under saddle
- ◆ No hoof polish/brack
- ◆ No braided or braided manes/tails or extensions
- ◆ Trimming inside ears is discouraged
- ◆ Trimming inside past is allowed
- ◆ Equipment with silver does not count over your working equipment and is discouraged
- ◆ Holding the saddle horn with either hand will not be permitted in any class
- ◆ Posting or standing in stirrups at extended trot is acceptable

It is up to individual competitors in green & intermediate classes to familiarize themselves with the RHA rules prior to entries. RHA rule book can be found at the link www.rha.com.au/rules
