

BWPC / HUSTLERS MEMBERS 2024 HIGH POINT BUCKLES SERIES ARE RUN UNDER BWPC RULES THIS HIGH POINT SERIES IS FOR SAME HORSE RIDER COMBINATION ALL SEASON UNLESS CHANGES APPROVED BY BWPC SHOW COMMITTEE. COMPETITION HIGH POINT WILL BE AWARDED TO THE HIGHEST POINT COMBINATION IN EACH LEVEL/DIVISION (EXCLUDING RANCH RIDING AND RANCH RAIL) RIDER MUST COMPETE IN 4 OF THE 5 RANCH WEEKEND FOR THE SEASON TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR BWPC / HUSTLERS POINTS, RANCH RIDING MEMBERS OVERALL HIGH POINT BUCKLE WINNER WILL BE THE HORSE RIDER COMBINATION WITH HIGHEST NUMBER OF POINTS IN RANCH RIDING ON THE VERSATILITY DAYS ONLY RANCH OF THE RAIL HIGH POINT WINNER WILL BE A PRIZE FOR THE HIGHEST POINT WINNER FROM 4 OF THE 5 SHOWS

RIDERS ARE LIMITED TO 2 LEVELS ONLY BUT CAN RIDE 2 LEVELS PLUS BWPC SPECIAL LEVEL AS WELL BUT ALL TACK RULES APPLY NOTE FOR FULL LISTING OF RULES SEE BELOW

Rules and Regulations:

BWPC Inc will take no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or theft to any persons/horses, vehicles, or property whilst at these shows. All competitors compete at their own risk. BWPC Inc reserves the right to refuse entry to any competitor.

- This show will run under the new AQHA Rule Book effective 1st August 2023
 All competitors MUST be either a member of AQHA or BWPC INC to be covered by insurance
- No pending registrations will be accepted. All age refers to the horse.
- ALL HORSE MUST BE 3YEARS AND OVER AS OF 1ST AUG 2023
- JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL any protests must go through AQHA rulings.
- DOGS must always be on a leash. Dogs are not permitted in the marshalling or main arenas.
- All vet fees and call out fees at competitors' expense, if required.
- ALL horses on the grounds MUST BE ENTERED in a class.
- All buildings are NON SMOKING ZONES so please observe this ruling
- Competitors/participants always have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses, to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion.
- ALL CASES OF MISS TREATMENT OF ANY ANIMAL WILL BE ACTED ON IMMEDIATLEY
 Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of AQHA, always demonstrate good sportsmanship, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials. First aid officers are available on the grounds during the show hours.
- Every horse entered for competition shall be under the control of the Show Manager or such person/s he appoints to act on his behalf.

- Only contestants in the specific classes and show officials will be allowed in the competition arena or marshalling area during the judging. Everyone handling a horse MUST be either an AQHA member or of BWPC INC.
- The Show Manager or such person he/she appoints shall have discretion to eject any exhibitor from the said area for inhumane treatment and/or training of any horse or failure to observe the Rules and Regulations of the competition and the Rules and Regulations of the AQHA or any reasonable request. Your co-operation is expected.
- Show management may exclude horses from competition should there be any unnecessary delay on the part of the exhibitor in bringing the horse into the competition arena. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to present themselves at the competition arena gate when called. Failure to report on final call will result in disqualification from the class. In the event that a horse is excluded from entry, all entry fees and charges for the class are forfeited without liability to the show organisers/committee.
- Show management reserve the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of any changes which will be posted at the Show Secretary's office and announced. Every endeavour will be made to give one hour's notice of any changes to the running order of events; however, every effort will be made to avoid changes.
- Any exhibitor or rider who refuses to obey the request of the Judge, Show Manager or any show official will be automatically disqualified from further competition at the show and forfeits all previous winnings together with all entry fees and other charges. At the discretion of the Show Manager or show committee, the offending individual and his/her entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.
- All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge and/or Show Management may, if he/she so desires have the animal examined by the Show Veterinarian and his decision shall be final.

HEALTH & SAFETY THIS IS PARAMOUNT AT EVERY SHOW Health & Safety Officer – will be appointed - all persons on the grounds must consider safety at all times

This show is subject to current QLD State Government COVID19 regulations

Code of conduct

No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working areas or show pen/contestant areas

All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form.

All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.

REFUNDS: Scratching of Horse or Rider prior to commencement of the Show must accompany relevant Vet or Doctor certificate (to be emailed within 7 days of the notification) If Covid related a positive covid test must be supplied. All refunds will go to next available committee meeting to be approved.

BWPC HIGH POINT RULES All points are for the same horse rider combination EXCEPT for Supreme Halter Horse which is points on the horse, any change to level or combinations must be approved by BWPC Committee

OTT LEVEL IS A CLASS FOR ANY HORSE TB OR STANDARD BRED THAT QUALIFIES AS AN OFF THE TRACK HORSE THIS IS BWPC LEVEL AND ONLY APPROVED FOR OUR 2024 BUCKLE SERIES HIGH POINTS AWARDS RIDER MUST BE A BWPC MEMBER AND HORSE MUST QUALIFY AS OTT HORSE

Beginner Walk Trots* highest point winner will be overall hp buckle winner the horse /rider combination must compete in 4 from the 5 shows in series Beginner Walk Trot riders cannot compete in any Lope/Canter classes. Beginners must have safe Gear Attire and Tack but need not necessarily be the correct Western requirements. All Beginner youth must compete in approved helmets in all classes No exception We must agree on your level at the beginning of series, and you must compete at that level during the full series

Rider cannot change levels during the series the horse\rider combination cannot rider in any lower or higher level The Series is based on the same horse rider combination for the series. Beginners cannot ride or handle Stallions

Improvers* have progressed from beginners walk trots. Improver Riders may choose to compete one or 2 handed and, in a snaffle, or a shank bit with a senior horse. Once you enter the arena that is how you must compete that class. So, if you enter one handed you must remain one handed for that entire class; if you revert to 2 handed you be judged accordingly with a loss of points or DQ BWPC Members Special Level Open to all MEMBERS horse/rider combinations— ANY HANDED,(BUT YOU MUST RIDE THE CLASS AS YOU ENTER YOU CANNOT CHANGE FROM ONE HAND TO TWO), AND LEGAL WESTERN BIT, (SNAFFLE OR SHANK), ANY HORSE -REGISTERED OR NOT, AGED FROM 3YEARS & OVER) AND ANY SADDLE (INCLUDING WESTERN, STOCK OR FENDER) and THIS combination can compete in this level and any TWO other levels but must follow all rules for the other level, and pay for each level . and this is a non sanctioned or AQHA approved class so only BWPC POINTS

Select, Master, All Age Youth and Amateur, must hold AQHA or other breed society relevant Card and forward copy with noms and all AQHA rules apply

Snaffle Bit Classes as per AQHA rules

Senior Horse is a horse that is 6 year or old as at 1st Aug 2023

Junior Horse is a horse that is between 3 and 5 years as at Aug 1st 2023

Prospects, are yearlings or 2 years as at August 1st 2023 and cannot be ridden only shown as Led Horse

Masters, 65 years and over must show proof of age i.e. drivers licence or birth certificate when first nominating

Ranch Riding horses must be at least 3 years old and are not permitted to compete in any Western Pleasure classes and Pleasure horse cannot compete in Ranch Riding at same show

In case of Hendra or El virus outbreak the Burpengary Western Performance Club Inc will not be responsible for any costs incurred or monies lost by an outbreak of Hendra or El to a competitor, spectator or volunteer.

Failure to abide by AQHA, BWPC rules & DPI&F Bio Security & BWPC Bio Security rules MAY result in instant disqualification from all shows and forfeiture of any monies paid or owing to the competitor.
