Horse/Rider combination ineligible to cross enter OPEN classes.</p> <p>GREEN HORSE (snaffle bit & hackamore only) Horse with minimal show experience. Professional or nonprofessional riders</p> <p>HERITAGE SNAFFLE BIT – Ineligible to cross enter ALL AGE, may cross enter Amateur/ Youth classes.</p> <p>OPEN CLASSES: Junior & Senior Horse, Amateur, Select, Masters and All Age; *must be ridden in the correct head gear in a western saddle per RHAA/AQHA rules *Junior horse: Horses five years-old (5) and younger *Senior Horse: Horses six-years (6) and older.</p> <p>See RHAA website for rules, equipment and class Guidelines.</p> <p>https://www.rhaa.com.au/rules</p>

<p>YOUTH RIDERS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7 to 18 years as of 1st August. • Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk, trot & lope. • Youth competitors are to wear an approved safety helmet whilst mounted. • Youth must not ride or handle a stallion at any time <p>GREEN HORSE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all riders – professional and nonprofessional – wanting to bring inexperienced horses (3 Yr and over) into the show arena. • Horses will be required to show at the walk, trot & lope. <p>GREEN RIDER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A class for inexperienced adult riders, open riders are NOT eligible for this class. • Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only. • The purpose of this class is to encourage those new to riding and/or new to showing. Those entered in this class are Ineligible for any Intermediate or Open classes 	<p>GREEN RIDER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A class for inexperienced adult riders, open riders are NOT eligible for this class. • Riders will be required to show their horses at the walk & trot only. The purpose of this class is to encourage those new to riding and/or new to showing. Those entered in this class are Ineligible for any Intermediate or Open classes <p>GUIDELINES ATTIRE: WESTERN ATTIRE MANDATORY; (All divisions) – long sleeved, collared button up shirt. – western hat (the hat must be on the rider’s head when the exhibitor enters the arena) or ASS approved safety helmet. – western pants/jeans – western boots. Optional Attire – Necktie, scarf, Spurs, chinks and chaps in ridden classes.</p>	<p>GUIDELINES GEAR</p> <p>No horse under 3 years of age may be exhibited under saddle, No hoof polish/black. No braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions, trimming inside ears is discouraged, trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of – fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair, Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit, Silver on bridles and – saddles is discouraged, Holding the saddle horn with either hand will not be penalised in any class. Posting or standing in stirrups at extended trot is acceptable. When exhibiting in a snaffle bit or hackamore, an exhibitor may switch between two hands and one hand on the reins at any time.</p> <p>GUIDELINES GENERAL</p> <p>All competitors agree to abide by the AQHA rules. <u>It is the responsibility of the competitor to understand the AQHA rules and conditions prior to entering.</u></p> <p>Only RHAA financial members will be eligible for RHAA EOY Hi Points.</p>
